Doctors Without Borders-Haiti Relief

At its last meeting, the PaMHC Board of Directors discussed ways it could

support the relief efforts in Haiti after an earthquake brought massive death and destruction on January 12, 2010. The group moved to donate \$250 to Doctors Without Borders (DWB) as a means to support the medical attention so desperately needed by the Haitians who have been injured in the quake. The Arabian Horsemen's Distress Fund

Longtime Arabian trainer and breeder Randy Stoneback suffered a devastating loss after a barn fire at his Pennsylvania facility claimed the lives of eight training horses, two of whom had just recently won National Championships at Sport Horse Nationals. Virtually all of the farm equipment, including trailer, tractors, spreaders, tack and hay have been destroyed. The fire, believed to have been electrical in nature, so quickly engulfed the building that the Stonebacks were able to get to only a few horses in that barn. The facility is comprised of several different barns, so over fifty stalls, and many more horses, still remain at the farm, but virtually all of their equipment and hay perished in the fire.

Obviously, there are many items needed immediately to continue the operations at the farm while they recover from this accident, as well as to replace much of the equipment. Friends who would like to help are welcome to send a tax deductible contribution to The Arabian Horsemen's Distress Fund, with a notation on the check that the funds are to be earmarked for the Stonebacks. The fund is a separate, restricted fund with 501c3 charitable status, managed by a five person board, and the family will be sent notification of all who have donated.

Morgans In the Spotlight

Task Force Morgan

The 340 members of Vermont's National Guard 172nd Cavalry squadron have taken the name "Task Force Morgan" for their upcoming mission. On December 11, they left Vermont for combat training in Indiana.

The Morgan horse is closely related to Vermont and its military history, playing an important role in many important Civil War battles.

"We thought Task Force Morgan was appropriate, especially since this is the first opportunity for the 172nd Cavalry to go into theater as a unit," Captain Christopher Gookin told *The Burlington Free Press*, Vermont's largest newspaper. "We're conscious of our cavalry forebears, and we wanted especially to live up to those deeds and attributes."

Following their training in Indiana, Task Force Morgan will travel to Afghanistan.

Courage To Lead is USEF Horse of the Year Candidate

The 12-year-old chestnut Morgan mare, Courage To Lead, is a nominee for the United States Equestrian Federation's (USEF) highest honor bestowed upon a horse—the Farnam/Platform USEF Horse of the Year Award. Owned by Beverly Leshner, Courage To Lead joins four other nominees who represent the

breadth of the Federation's breeds and disciplines.

Not once, but twice, has Courage To Lead (Courage Of Equinox x Hartland Sable) had a brush with career-ending injuries. Bouncing back from each of them is a testament to this mare's heart and dedication to excellence. And in 2009, this was evident in a string of first-place victories at the hands of USEF Equestrian of the Year nominee Suzy Stafford.

Crowned champions at the USEF National Single Pony Combined Driving competition, the duo also put down the best overall FEI score. At the Live Oak International, they placed first in the FEI Single Pony competition and were awarded the Hanzi Award for Best Horse or Pony as determined by the event's FEI judges. For their hard work and string of wins, the pony and Stafford were named to the U.S. Pony Team to compete in Greven, Germany, for the World Pony Championships, where they ultimately took home a Bronze medal and helped their team achieve a fourth-place finish overall. This year's awards will be presented during the 2009 Horse of the Year celebration as part of the USEF's Annual Meeting. The gala will take place at the Downtown Marriott Louisville on January 15.

Suzy Stafford is 2009 USEF Equestrian of Honor

Suzy Stafford of Bear, Delaware, has been announced as the United States Equestrian Federation (USEF) Beck Grand Hart Trophy winner. The trophy, which is presented to international non-Olympic athletes, was given to Stafford during the Pegasus Awards on January 16, 2010 at the Downtown Marriot in Louisville, Kentucky. Known as the USEF Equestrians of Honor, Stafford joins six other stars of equestrian sport across breed and discipline who have been named recipients of different competitive trophies.

The National Single Pony Championship Gold Medal was awarded for the third time to Stafford this year,

after she guided Courage To Lead to the win at the Kentucky Classic CDE. The duo also was awarded an individual bronze medal at the FEI World Combined Pony Driving Championship in Germany in 2009.

One of the seven USEF award winners will be named the overall Equestrian of the Year. This is determined by a combination of an online vote of the general USEF membership, equestrian media, and the USEF Board of Directors.

The Breeders' Hall of Fame honors a breeder(s) who has produced Morgans that have had a significant impact on the breed. This year's honorees are Cedar Creek Farm, Tara Farm, and Tennessee Valley Morgans.

The Golden Reins Awards is given to a Morgan professional who has a 30-year career in training or instruction. Harold Angell, Lynn and Kathy Peeples, and Pierre Loisselle will receive this special honor.

Claudia Grimes will be honored for her outstanding contributions to the Morgan Youth program as the Youth Person of the Year.

Suzu Stafford will receive the Morgan International Award for her dedication to overseas competition with Courage To Lead.

Two Morgans will be honored for their work with people with disabilities. This year's honorees are Lenawee Madonna, owned by Patricia D'Andrea; and Janlees' Philharmonica, owned by Janlee Morgans.

Born To Boogie, Hyland Acres Command, and Topa's Krystal will be inducted into AMHA's Show Horse Hall of Fame.

We hope you will be able to join these awardees when their longtime support and dedication are recognized before the Morgan community. The 2010 AMHA Convention is chock full of many fun Morgan events. Farm tours, trainer roundtables, a mini judging school, and historical seminars are just some of the highlights that will celebrate the Morgan horse in Lexington.

Equine Humor Equestrian Definitions

Colt – what your mare always gives you when you want a filly.

Horseman’s Corner Canine Influenza

The “canine influenza virus” (CIV) is an influenza A H3N8 influenza virus (not a human influenza virus) that was originally an equine (horse) influenza virus. This virus has spread to dogs and can now spread between dogs.

Since it was first discovered, canine influenza has been causing localized outbreaks around the country. A recent large outbreak was in Fairfax County, VA where the disease closed the Fairfax County Animal Shelter and spurred at least one nearby veterinary hospital to set up a quarantine unit.

Because CIV is a disease new to dogs, they have virtually no immunity to it and it is highly contagious, says Mary Ann Vande Linde, CDVM, director of organizational development at Pender Veterinary Centre in Fairfax, VA.

Dog owners should be aware that any situation in which dogs are brought together increases the risk of exposure. The disease is spread from dog to dog through coughing or sneezing, but it can also contaminate bowls, leashes, collars and the hands of people who handle sick dogs. Frequent hand washing and disinfection may help in prevent the spread of CIV.

Canine Influenza Facts:

Unlike most human influenza, canine “flu” is not seasonal. It can occur at any time of year.

Virtually all exposed dogs will be become infected.

Of those dogs, 80% will develop respiratory illness, while the remaining 20% will not.

While the overall mortality rate is low and most dogs recover with supportive care within two weeks, a small percentage will become severely ill and some may even die.

Dogs of any age, breed, or size are susceptible to infection.

If you suspect that your dog is exhibiting signs of a respiratory infection (sneezing, coughing, nasal discharge, fever), isolate the dog then call your veterinarian first before bringing your pet to the office.

In May 2009, the USDA approved the first canine influenza vaccine. Although the vaccine may not prevent infection, dogs that are vaccinated typically do not get as sick as unvaccinated dogs and tend to recover more quickly. The vaccine is useful for dogs that may be exposed to high-risk situations, such as time spent in a kennel or boarding facility, visits to a dog park, or dog shows. Contact your veterinarian about the canine influenza vaccine.
